Alternative Education Institute

The Alternative Education Institute (AEI) is a youth serving program that assists court involved, formerly incarcerated and disconnected youth between the ages of 16-25 reconnect with their communities. AEI engages young people who are neither working nor in school, in service and service learning opportunities.

AEI goal is to help students work towards obtaining their NJ State High School Diploma. Upon program completion AEI Staff continue to work with students to help them continue their education via college or trade school or help them obtain employment.

The AEI program focuses on three educational components: Academics, Career, and Leadership. The AEI curriculum focuses on Math, Social Studies, Science, English, Reading, and Writing. Students also participate in developing career plans, completing community service, and community development.

Program Components:

Academic Component- Participants will receive academic instruction to help them work towards a NJ State High School Diploma

The AEI curriculum focuses on Math, Social Studies, Science, English, Reading, and Writing.

Career Component-Participants will focus on developing a career plan.

Leadership Component-Participants will focus on character and community development. They will learn how to use their leadership skills to make changes in their lives and their neighborhoods.
